

Special Incidents Requiring an SMP

Victim or accused in 3 or more of the following must be referred for a SMP:

- **B5P** – Inappropriate use of physical intervention;
- **D1P** – Self-harm behavior: attempting to suffocate, strangle or hang self;
- **D2P** – Self-harm behavior: cutting, puncturing, or scratching self with sharp objects or re-opening wounds, excluding tattoos;
- **D4P** – Self-harm behavior: ingesting, inserting or attempting to ingest or insert chemicals, hoarding medications or objects that can cause self-harm;
- **D6P** – Self-harm behavior: threatening to jump or jumping from a height, head banging, and hair pulling, or hitting self;
- **D7P** – Self-harm behavior: verbal threats, written statements or drawings about suicide or self-harm;
- **P1P** – Use of Force without mechanical restraint to physically compel youth to comply with a directive;
- **P2P** – Use of Force with mechanical restraint for security purposes;
- **P3P** – Use of Force technique, with mechanical restraint for therapeutic purposes;
- **P5P** – Use of a chemical agent;
- **F1P** – Youth on youth physical altercation, with an injury severity rating of 3 or less;
- **F2P** – Youth on staff physical altercation;
- **PY2** – Youth on youth sexual contact on DJJ property;
- **PY3** – Youth on youth sexual harassment on DJJ property;
- **M1P** – Youth Lewd or Lascivious Exhibitionism;
- **M2P** – Youth lewd or Lascivious Behavior (Two or more);
- **G5P** – Contraband discovered at a facility, other than nuisance contraband
- **H4P** – Group Disturbance;
- **H6P** – Substantial damage to state property over \$1000 or more; or
- **F5P** – Youth on Staff /Contract/Volunteer/Intern Sexual Contact.

Special Incidents Requiring an SMP

Victim or accused in any of the following must be referred for an SMP:

- **B1P** – Child abuse, physical (as victim);
- **PS1** - Staff/contractor/volunteer/intern on youth sexual penetration;
- **PY1** – Youth on youth sexual penetration on DJJ property;
- **PS2** - Staff/contractor/volunteer/intern on youth sexual contact;
- **F1P** – Youth on youth physical altercation with injury severity rating of 4 or more;
- **G3P** – Mistreatment of a youth, no injury (as victim);
- **R1P** – Escape from a secure facility;
- **R2P** – Attempted escape from a secure facility;
- **R3P** – Escape from secure custody while off-site;
- **R4P** – Attempted escape from secure custody while off-site; or
- **E5P** – Emergency/urgent psychotropic medication administration injectable.
