

**“GOOD BEHAVIOR”
COMMUNITY CHECKLIST**

MINIMUM CRITERIA:

- At least 12 months of Intensive supervision (successful completion of HITS, if available)
- No moderate or serious violations under the Graduated Sanctions program.
- No new delinquent or adult charges (this includes charges that are pending)
- Substantial progress towards treatment and service plan objectives, as determined by the case manager and JPM
- Completion of sex offender treatment, if applicable
- Completion of or active participation in substance abuse treatment/services, if applicable
- On track with academic goals, Completion of high school diploma, GED and/or gainful, documented employment
- Completion of a Service Learning Project
- Compliance with a specific and documented Restitution Plan, if applicable

DOCUMENTATION THAT MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE REQUEST:

- A copy of the original order of disposition and plea agreement (if applicable)
- A copy of any subsequent related orders (i.e. early release)
- Documentation showing the name of counsel (attorney) present at the original adjudication/disposition, if available (usually this is stated in the court order)
- Detailed recommendation from the youth’s community case manager that modification/termination is in the best interest of the youth
- Current legal history from JTS, this must include all adult charges
- Graduated Sanctions history
- Academic progress and accomplishments during youth’s restrictive custody and aftercare
- PDRA and CRN scores
- A statement from the juvenile court clerk accounting for all restitution and court fees that have been paid, including the youth’s restitution plan
- Sexually Abusive Youth Relapse Prevention Plan and Safety/Supervision Plan; if applicable
- All six month DF reports
- Statement from the youth of his/her overall progress
- Statement from youth’s parent/guardian of youth’s overall progress
- Victim Impact Statement if already in the youth’s case file (DO NOT request a statement from the victim and DO NOT have the youth write a victim impact statement)
- Victim Contact Information
