Assessment Checklist for RBWO

- Screening Recommendation Form with screening packet
- Current Social History (in JTS); Legal History up to date (in JTS); Placement history up to date (in JTS); DJJ Home Study Report
- If jointly committed, CCFA (Comprehensive Child & Family Assessment). IF DFCS has had custody for 30 days---this should be available.
- If jointly committed, DFCS custody order, if joint custody is not indicated on the DJJ commitment order
- Current Psychological within 2 years; within 1 year if Wilderness is recommended at screening
- Psychiatric Evaluation, if applicable
- Psychosexual Evaluation, if applicable
- Competency Evaluation, if applicable
- MPI-I (completed correctly & completely with behavior descriptions-use the automated version)
- Educational Records: For all youth-*transcripts, achievement testing, discipline reports from at least the past year; if not in school for the past year, then include the most recent educational records*
- If the child is in **special education** also include at minimum, the most recent IEP, eligibility report form, and school psychological (psycho-ed report).*
- If youth was hospitalized, include discharge summar(ies) if available
- If youth has been placed out of home previously, include discharge summar(ies) if available
- Is this youth on any medication? Be sure to include this information on the social summary in JTS.
- Medical Records, if applicable and if youth is in the RY these should be available from the RY; Be sure to include any medical issues/problems on the social summary in JTS.
LIPT (Local Interagency Planning Team staffing from)-**all** portions completed fully with past placements including hospitalizations and community services). Please note, if all other items required for the RBWO assessment have been submitted to the ACS and the youth is in secure detention and the LIPT meeting is scheduled, but has not occurred, the LIPT staffing form will be completed in full except for the LIPT committee's recommendation.
- Any other pertinent case information.
