- * A face-to-face with the youth or parent can be made in lieu of a phone or correspondence contact with the youth or parent (if youth is 18 years old, or older, a face-to-face can be made in lieu of a collaborative contact).
- * A home visit is a visit to the youth's residence where contact is made with the youth or the youth and parent/guardian.
- * Designated felons will receive an intensive supervision level or be supervised by a High Intensity Team, if available, as ordered by the court and the requirements of the program.
- * Sexually abusive youth will receive supervision based upon their JSOAP II score and JNA level of Service.
- * For all youth assigned a community case manager and pending Superior Court action, the community case manager will maintain contact with the youth. For youth not assigned a community case manager and pending Superior Court action, the Case Expeditor will maintain contact with the youth.
- * No parent/guardian contacts will be made for emancipated youth or for youth who are 18 years old, or older, and living outside of the parent/guardian's home. The contact with the parent/guardian will be replaced with an additional face-to-face contact with the youth.
