- * At any supervision level, a face-to-face contact may substitute for a collaborative contact or "other" contact. A face-to-face contact with the youth and the parent may occur on the same date and time.
- * Designated felons will receive an intensive supervision level, be supervised by a High Intensity Team, or a combination of both for at least one year after release from a YDC.
- * Sexually abusive youth will receive supervision based upon their JSORRAT-II score and CRN level of risk.
- * For all youth assigned a community case manager and pending Superior Court action, the community case manager or other designated staff will maintain contact with the youth. For youth not assigned a community case manager and pending Superior Court action, the Case Expeditor will maintain contact with the youth.
- * No parent/guardian contacts will be made for emancipated youth. The contact with the parent/guardian will be replaced with an additional face-to-face contact with the youth.
- * No parent/guardian contacts will be made for youth who are 18 years of age and living outside of the parent/guardian's home. The contact with the parent/guardian will be replaced with an additional face-to-face contact with the youth.
