**DIRECTIVE:**

**This directive is issued to change attendance requirement for Case Expeditors in courts within their catchment area.**

**This directive therefore strikes the following language currently listed under DJJ 20.2 Detention Monitoring (Section III Procedures, Letter B, #2);**

Each Case Expeditor will attend juvenile court proceedings in each court in their catchment area at least monthly.

**And replaces this verbiage with the following procedure:**

Each Case Expeditor will maintain contact with each juvenile court in their catchment area at least once a month. At least once every two months, the case expeditor will attend juvenile court proceedings in all courts in their catchment area.
